As a result, the endowment of deposits in the FSU had a noticeable tendency to shrink with time during conversion from P to C. However, this does not always mean that the initial P estimate was incorrect, although it is often very speculative and overly optimistic. Because of such an approach to exploration and resource delineation, there is a split in opinion whether the FSU is over- or underexplored. On one hand, the entire FSU territory (one-sixth of the world's land. Even though oil and gas were sold to the West at world prices, domestic producers were paid industry wholesale prices that were a small fraction of the world price. As a result, exploration and production equipment have become quite primitive and old and unable to sustain level of production from aging and damaged fields. The end result was an irrational use of resources, depletion of reservoirs, and decreased production levels. The equipment and infrastructure have also been environmentally unsafe.
