Most of the knowledge in moral development literature depend largely on theories developed by Piaget, Kohlberg and later theories. Contributions from Gilligan and Turiel are represented relatively limited. Carol Gilligan and Moral Development Carol Gilligan stated already existing theories were developed mainly for man which was a problem (Austrian, 2008). Gilligan pointed out the quality differences women and men moral judgment (Talbot, 2002). Gilligan proposed two models in her theory which are "ethic of care" and "ethic of justice" (Gilligan, 2003; Jaffe & Hyde, 2000; Kyte, 1996; Rhodes, 1985).
