value of a single unit, and then finding the necessary value by multiplying the single unit value. In essence, this method is used to find  
the value of a unit from the value of a multiple, and hence the value of a multiple. For example, to solve the problem: "A man walks 7  
miles in 2 hours. How far does he walk in 7 hours?", one would first calculate how far the man walks in 1 hour. One can safely assume
